- II. Designate quorum with 7 of 9 board members present.

- V. Open Forum/Visitor Presentation
 - A. Debbie Boe, Chair Chaska Heritage Preservation Committee (HPC), and Steve Mueller, Vice Chair, HPC.
 - 1. Two possible areas for Historic Registry designation: Carvers Green and Jonathan New Town Development
 - 2. Local designation vs. state vs. national registry, differences and impact to be determined
 - 3. D. Boe explains process of designation by HPC, HPC can recommend, City Council has to approve recommendations.
 - 4. D. Snodgrass asks how designated properties are improved as people learn how to do things better with more modern materials and processes.
 - 5. D. Boe explained that properties designated would be expected to maintain historic appearance and materials; enforced by requiring approval from HPC for future modifications by owners of those properties. Possibly push additional responsibility to ARC.
 - 6. L. Frey questions benefit to the homeowners of such properties from these additional restrictions and expenses
 - 7. D. Snodgrass questions how designation helps homeowners when Jonathan Association already has covenants and ARC to maintain standards.
 - 8. D. Boe provides example of Bavaria Rd walking path along the road as being historically incorrect. D. Snodgrass and N. Bostrom observe that McKnight's vision

- would have embraced changes to be compatible with the way people's lifestyles have changed.
- 9. N. Dilks asks if historical designation is a benefit or hindrance for resale values. D. Boe and S. Mueller unsure.
- 10. K. Alcindor is concerned with duplication of efforts by Jonathan Association's Heritage Committee and HPC.
- 11. K. Cutler asks if HPC could require homeowners to make changes to their properties. D. Boe explains HPC is only involved when property owner is instigating a change.
- 12. HPC would like 2 members of the Jonathan Board of Directors to serve as representatives on the committee to designate properties.
- 13. D. Boe explains that if Jonathan Board is not on board with historical designation, HPC would likely not proceed.
- 14. Dick Hagen is willing to serve as at large member of HPC Selection Committee if Jonathan Board chooses to pursue this option.
