## **Current Status/Update**

Heritage Committee met on 11-2-09 at the home of Marie Esch to determine the next steps in the ongoing compiling of filmed interviews of Jonathan pioneers. Maria Awes was also in attendance so as to provide a professional insight into the filming and documentary process. Maria stressed the importance that Jonathan/Heritage Committee remember to maintain possession of all Jonathan-related material (films, DVD, photos, books, etc) and to not give away any of this history without first letting the elected Jonathan Board of Directors discuss and vote on these matters. Mary Booth – current president of the Carver County Historical Society, and current chair of the Jonathan Heritage Committee – admitted that whatever the CCHS "stores" on site becomes its possession to keep. The Jonathan Heritage Committee members did not want to see any Jonathan historical materials or keepsake (in any form) be turned over or given away to the CCHS or any other organization unless the Jonathan Board of Directors had first discussed and decided to do this. The Heritage Committee members present were in favor, however – when/if possible – of producing 3 copies of photos and documents for the purpose of saving 1 set of these copies in each of 3 different locations (Jonathan, Chaska History Center, Carver County Historical Society). No decision was made concerning an item such as the model of Jonathan currently being stored in the Karen House attic.
