Current Status/Update

Phase Two of filmed interviews for documentary scheduled for late October, early November.

Jerome Foundation grant request was submitted by Maria Awes in May 2011, and the Jerome Foundation evaluated and subsequently declined the request by Committee Films.

Mary Booth (Jonathan Heritage Committee member & Carver County Historical Society member) discussed with Nate Bostrom the idea of Jonathan giving the scale model display once used at the original Jonathan sales office (and now is in storage in the Karen House attic) to the Carver County Museum. Nate followed up with Tracy Swanson of the Chaska History Center; Tracy said that she has no room in her facility and thought it a good idea to give the scale model to Carver County. This transfer would be a permanent ownership change in status for this item. NOTE: this item is currently too large for display use in the Karen House or Chaska History Center. It is also in bad condition and could benefit from the permanent care/talents of professional curators. Mary Booth, Tracy Swanson, and Nate Bostrom are all in favor of this permanent ownership transfer.
