

POLICY RESOLUTION # 15 – Jonathan Association Board of Directors

DATE: December 11, 2012

RE: Lake Grace Pavilion “BHAG” & Chaska Boy Scout Troop # 589

While acknowledging that:

1. The Jonathan Association is the original charter sponsor (39 + years) of Troop # 589, one of the longest BSA/Charter organization relationships in Minnesota history; and,
2. As charter sponsor, Jonathan serves as owner and insurance provider of the Troop’s physical assets (tents, trailer, camping equipment, etc.); and,
3. Chaska Boy Scout Troop # 589 is assisting the Jonathan Association in the renovation (including design and fundraising) of the Pavilion at Lake Grace and the surrounding lakefront area; and,
4. The Pavilion at Lake Grace is a Jonathan-owned asset which is considered to be, on a “first among equals” basis, a property which is maintained and provided primarily (but not exclusively) for the use of Troop # 589; and,

In addition to reaffirming that:

5. While Jonathan members not affiliated with Troop # 589 might be interested in using/reserving the Pavilion at Lake Grace for special events; and,
6. While Chaska residents, groups, and organizations not affiliated with Troop # 589 outside of Jonathan might be interested in using/reserving the Pavilion at Lake Grace for special events; and,
7. While the Jonathan Association cannot/will not guarantee (via contract, etc.) that the Pavilion at Lake Grace is a physical asset which exists solely for use by Troop # 589;

The Jonathan Association Board of Directors resolves on this day (12-11-2012) to make the priority consideration Chaska Boy Scout Troop # 589 with regard to the scheduling of the Pavilion at Lake Grace prior to giving usage approval to any other individuals and groups based on the schedule proved by the Boy Scouts.
