

POLICY RESOLUTION # 17 – Jonathan Association Board of Directors

DATE: July 9, 2013

RE: Charter Sponsorship of Chaska Boy Scout Troop # 589

While acknowledging that:

1. The Jonathan Association is the original charter sponsor (39+ years) of Troop # 589, one of the longest BSA/Charter organization relationships in Minnesota history; and,
2. As charter sponsor, Jonathan has served as owner and insurance provider of the Troop's physical assets (tents, trailers, camping equipment, etc.); and,
3. Jonathan has recognized 86 Scouts and Adult Leaders of Troop # 589 with Seedling Awards for volunteer activities which have benefitted the Association; and,

In addition to affirming that:

4. Jonathan is unable to provide a meeting facility for regular Troop events; and,
5. Jonathan is unable to provide a storage facility for Troop equipment; and,
6. Jonathan is unable to provide a location for aluminum can recycling collection; and,
7. Jonathan is unable to guarantee an increase of, or even maintain, its current level of financial support going into the future; and,
8. Jonathan is no longer home to a majority of Troop # 589 Scouts and Adult Leaders;

The Jonathan Association Board of Directors, on this day (07/09/2013) resolve to implement disassociation between the BSA Chaska Boy Scout Troop # 589 and the Jonathan Association, effective on or before 12-31-2013.
