

POLICY RESOLUTION # 23 – Jonathan Association Board of Directors

DATE: January 10, 2017

RE: Bridge in Neighborhood 3

While acknowledging that:

1. The Jonathan Association had a trail bridge in Neighborhood 3 (south of Warner Circle, West of Bender Road South, and North of Hidden Creek Place); and,
2. The Neighborhood 3 bridge was damaged causing it to be closed; and,
3. Board research has determined that the bridge should not be replaced due to landscape features and erosion; and,
4. Board research indicates that the expense would be exorbitant; and,
5. It was impossible to find a contractor to bid on replacing the bridge; and,
6. Path connections exist both from Hidden Creek Place path and from the south side of Warner Circle.

In addition to reaffirming that:

7. To save future boards time and research; and,
8. To make the most fiscally responsible and safest decision;

The Jonathan Association Board of Directors resolves on this day (1-10-17) to deem the trail bridge in Neighborhood 3 obsolete and abandoned.
